Aussie Lager (3)

A light, well balanced Australian lager with subtle malt and hop flavours finishing and a medium level of bitterness. A perfect beer style for our hot dry Australian climate. Champion Draught Beer, Royal Sydney Beer Show 2016

Felda Weiss (4)

A Classic German style wheat beer brewed true to style with hints of tropical fruit, banana and citrus. It has a sweet malty profile and exhibits a crisp acidity with a dry cleansing finish. 4.6%

Honey Ale (1)

Munich Lager (6)

This Keller beer is a modern twist on Germany's traditional Oktoberfest Lager. Germany's biggest beer festival: Oktoberfest is held each year to celebrate the wedding of Prince Ludwig in 1810. Traditionally the festival goes 'until the beer runs out'. 4.4% 7.5 ♦ 9.5 ♦ 13 ♦ 22



Organic Pale Ale (5)

English style ale brewed using certified organically grown malt and hops. A special London Ale yeast brings out a lovely stone fruit character and crisp bitterness and a rich malty flavour, making it a flavoursome and refreshing ale. 4.6%

Apple Thief Cider (7)

A locally made cider from Blue Mountains made from freshly crushed Batlow apples to create a delicious crystal clear cider with a clean medium to sweet finish. 4.5%

Red Earth (10)

An Aussie mid strength ale brewed with our own grown Red earth hops, the hops give off a spicy and woody aroma with a citrus undertone. 3.5%

Bock (8)

Bock is a German dark strong lager, brewed with Munich malts, Noble Hallertau hops and Bavarian lager yeast. It's a robust beer in both flavour and history as it dates back to medieval days in Einbeck during the 1400's. 6.8%

Hopness Monster (11)

Not for the faint-hearted, a rich, strong and flavoursome beer. A full-bodied bitter with strong caramel toffee notes and floral aromas. A smooth drinking ale with an elusive linger of bitterness. 6%

A Belgian IPA, nicknamed Fat Abbot, brewed with Belgian Trappist yeasts and Belgian candy sugar. The fruity aroma, sweet malty flavour and citrus notes are followed by the kick of alcohol. 6.5%

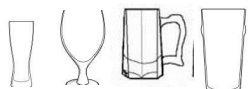
West Coast Pale Ale (12)

In celebration of America's west coast, we have used loads of American hops for the bitterness and hoppy fruit aroma. Think tangerine and pineapple on the nose. 4.6%
