whisky vs beer

Whisky and beer use the same basic ingredients - malted grain, yeast and water. However, hops are added to beer for bitterness. Whisky and beer also share the same first steps of processing and people managing initial processing is called a brewer. Whisky is distilled, whereas beer is fermented.
